In second session the student were taken to Hospital Pharmacy at 2.00 pm. The student were educated on arrangement of medicine, methods of dispensing and Prescription.



Saree Day (24th January 2020)


- On this day the Girls were supposed to wear sarees and for Boys it was the Tie day. There were




